Year 3 Camp Out

Dear Parents.

We are extremely pleased to be offering the children in Year 3 the very exciting opportunity to participate in our Summer Camp Out. This is an event where children can camp out overnight, within our school grounds, on Friday 5th July.

There's nothing like spending time outdoors, after dark - with nocturnal creatures taking over the night shift! We hope it will be like entering another world and be a great experience for the children! Most importantly, we want the children to experience nature in a new and inspiring way and, of course, have a great time! We know that to protect nature people need to care about it, so we'd love your child to strengthen their connection with the natural world by taking part in our Camp Out – fully supervised by school staff, and held within the safety of our school grounds.

This event will begin at 6pm, when the children should arrive at school to set up camp and cook themselves a small evening snack - over a roaring camp fire! The children will then take part in a number of activities, including a walk to Pepper Wood, before settling down for a good night's sleep! In the morning children will cook themselves breakfast before packing up and getting ready to be collected at 9am.

This event is only open to the children in Year 3, if you would like your child to take part we ask that you make a contribution of £7, (to cover the cost of food, fire wood, resources etc.) and complete the online consent via ParentPay, by Monday 17th June.

By ticking the online consent, you agree that your child/children can attend the Camp Out, walk to Pepper Wood and also agree that medical/dental treatment may be given to your child/children if necessary, including the administration of a general anaesthetic and to surgical operations in the case of an emergency, in accordance with the recommendations of a qualified medical practitioner.

The swimming pool will be on site during this event but children will not have access, at any point.
